March 27: Riverkeeper Dinner, Wyandotte Boat Club- TIME TBA

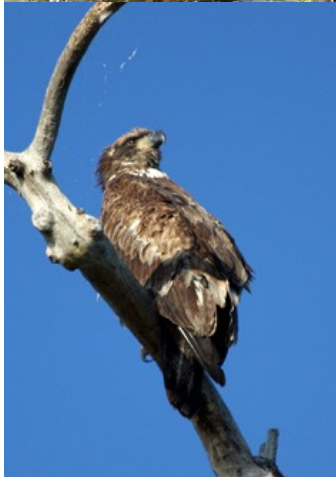
